

Recovery Houses of Rochester Supportive Housing Rules

- 1) Residents must abstain from the use of alcohol and drugs while living in supportive housing of RHR.
- 2) Residents must be responsible for their share of the monthly expenses.
- 3) Residents will pay a \$25.00 late fee if rent is paid after the 3rd of each month.
- 4) Residents who return to using drugs and/or alcohol will be expelled immediately. Steps will be taken to place resident in a safe in structured environment.
- 5) Residents moving out of the residence after 90 days for reasons other than relapse will receive their security deposit back in 30 days and after inspection of their room and house.
- 6) Residents moving out of the residence before 90 days will not receive the security deposit back unless they chose not to move into the house.
- 7) Residents may be required to take a Alcohol Test and/or drug- test, residents who test positive will have to leave residence immediately.
- 8) Residents evicted for using drugs or alcohol will forfeit their security deposit.
- 9) Residents will be responsible for keeping any prescribed medications in a safe manner. RHR is not responsible for residents taking medication.
- 10) All residents are expected to attend the weekly house meeting unless they are employed or it has been approved by staff.
- 11) Residents are not allowed to store any food in their bedrooms, any food found stored in bed rooms could terminate your stay.
- 12) Residents will notify peers with a name and phone number where they can be reached if they decide to stay
- 13) Out overnight after their 30 day probationary period.
- 14) Residents' guest/visitors are not allowed in the house after 9: pm and not before 9:00am.
- 15) Residents must respect the House and all that is in it including furniture, heat, etc.
- 16) Residents are expected to complete their chore daily and clean up after themselves daily
- 17) Residents are expected to maintain personal hygiene daily.
- 18) Residents are not allowed to smoke in the house at no time.
- 19) Residents must understand that profanity when spoken tears down, and are asked to strive to make every effort to talk to one another with respect failure to do so could terminate your stay.
- 20) Residents are expected to have a plan for recovery and will be expected to follow it. Failure to follow your written plan may jeopardize your stay in RHR supportive housing.
- 21) RHR staff and volunteers will not be held responsible for the theft or lost of any resident's personal belongings.
- 22) Residents who leave RHR supportive housing for any reason, have 30 days in which to remove all of their personal belonging. If belongings are not removed from the house within 30 days, RHR will donate to charity.
- 23) Residents who consistently do not adhere to the house rules will run the risk of being expelled from the house.

23) Residents will not be allowed a key the first 30 days to the house.

I acknowledge the rules of Recovery Houses of Rochester Supportive Housing. I also understand that failure to follow the identified house rules will result in my being expelled from housing with RHR.
